

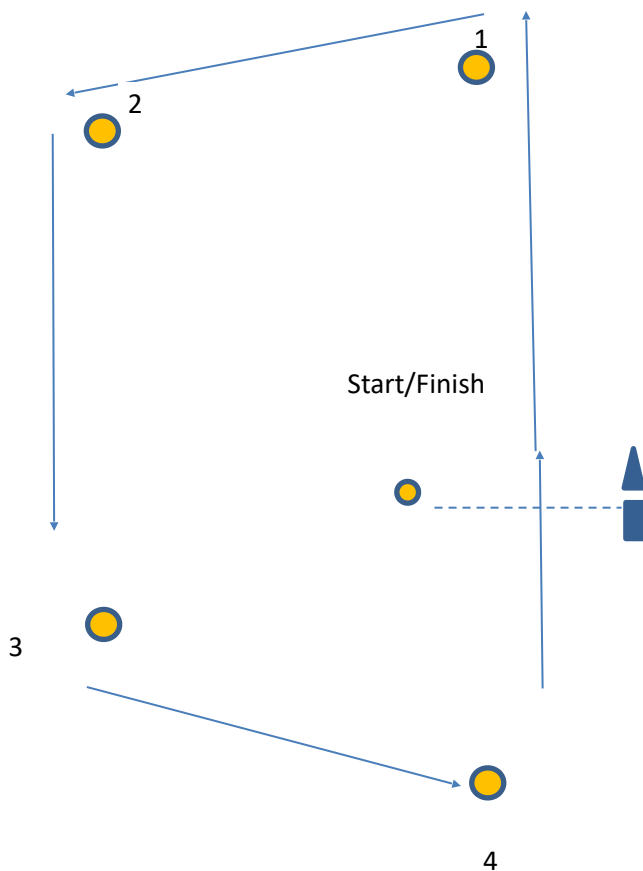
## Supplementary Sailing Instructions for Bart's Bash and Battle of the Beaches

September 11, 2022

Issued 2 September 2022

These Supplementary Sailing instructions include the Notices to Competitors and will be displayed on the Lancing Sailing Club Website and supplied to Shoreham Sailing Club

- 1 Two Races back to back
- 2 Starts  
First Start 11:00, second race as soon as possible after the first race has completed.
- 3 Racing area(s) Off Lancing Sailing Club East to Shoreham, dependant on boat entries of PY>1192 and above
- 4 The Course Offset Trapezium with gate  
Gate to be passed through on each lap  
Race length should be circa 40 mins for the fastest boat.



Total Course length depending on wind strength, but ideally 1,500 metres per lap

## Marks to port

- 5 Marks will be large orange
- 6 The Start  
Start Sequence 5, 4, 1, go
- 7 Signals: Displayed on Committee boat accompanied by sound signal  
5 Minutes Code Flag F up  
4 Minutes Code Flag P up  
1 Minute Code Flag P down  
0 Minute Code Flag F down  
Postpone Flag Answering Pennant  
Individual Recall Code Flag X  
General RecallSub 1 Pennant  
Change of Course Code Flag A  
Postpone Flag down start accompanied by sound signal, sequence resumed as soon as possible
- 8 Change of course  
If necessary change of the next leg of the course Code Flag A from Safety Boat with 2  
Sound signals
- 9 The Finish will be through the gate Code Flag S will be shown on the Committee boat
- 10 Penalty system. Only change: Any boat that hits the Committee boat will be scored DSQ
- 11 Target Time for each race circa 40 minutes with boats not finishing within 20 minutes of the first boat, given their time at this point.
- 12 Protests, Requests for Redress and protest time limits. Protests must be logged with the committee boat or ashore within one hour of the end of the races or as soon as possible ashore if later
- 13 Scoring using Portsmouth Yardstick 2021 average laps. Race one counts for Bart's Bash. Races 1 & 2 comprise races 5 & 6 of Battle of the Beaches.
- 14 Depending on the conditions the evening before, the Committee boat will either be QuickSilver or a yellow Committee boat launched from Lancing Sailing Club beach.  
Support Boats two ribs from Shoreham SC and one from Lancing SC.
- 15 Radios and Call signs Channel 1.  
Committee boat call sign Caravan, Safety boats Rib 1 (LSC), Jaffa and Yellow Peril (Shoreham SC)
- 16 Results will be posted on the LSC Website and emailed to Shoreham SC as soon as possible.
- 17 Discards for Battle of the Beaches if all 6 races sailed 5 to count, 5, 4 and if only the 4 to date 1 discard.
