# SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS To be read in conjunction with the RS Association Standard Sailing Instructions, Reference RS GBR Std SI 2022 Ver. 1.

#### 1 RULES

1.3 Racing Rules, Race Signals 'Y', Race Signals 'AP', 27.1, 31, 34, 35, 40, 41.1, 60.1(a), 60.1(b), 61.3, 62.1(a), 62.2, A2, A5.1 and A5.2 will be changed. These changes appear, in full, in these Sailing Instructions.

#### 3 COMMUNICATIONS WITH COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice boards located in the Clubhouse entry foyer, and externally, adjacent to the Clubhouse entrance door.

#### 5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the main flagpole atop the Public Toilet block.
- 5.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.
- 5.3 [DP] Flag D with one sound means boats shall not leave the shore until this signal is made. The warning signal will not be made before the scheduled time or less than 15 minutes after flag D is displayed.

#### 7 CLASS FLAGS

7.1 Code Flag 'R'.

#### 9 COURSES

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward or Trapezoid. The diagrams in Addendum A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be passed.
- 9.2 The courses to be sailed will be indicated by the display of Numeral Pennants with the Starting Sequence Signal as described at Standard Sailing Instruction 6.2.

#### 10.4 MARKS: WINDWARD - LEEWARD

- 10.4.1 The Starting Line port end mark will be a Yellow cylindrical pencil buoy.
- 10.4.2 Mark 1 will be an Orange inflatable cylindrical buoy.
- 10.4.3 Mark 1A will be a Red/Orange spherical buoy.
- 10.4.4 Marks 4S and 4P will each be an Orange inflatable cylindrical buoy.
- 10.4.5 The Finishing Line port end mark will be a Black squat inflatable buoy.

#### 10.5 MARKS: TRAPEZOID

- 10.5.1 The Starting Line port end mark will be a Yellow cylindrical pencil buoy.
- 10.5.2 Mark 1 will be an Orange inflatable cylindrical buoy.
- 10.5.3 Mark 4 will be an Orange inflatable cylindrical buoy.
- 10.5.4 Mark 2 will be an Orange inflatable cylindrical buoy.
- 10.5.5 Mark 3 will be a Black squat inflatable buoy.
- 10.5.6 Mark 5 will be a Black squat inflatable buoy.
- 10.5.7 The Finishing Line port end mark will be as for the Staring Line.

#### 11 OBSTRUCTIONS

11.1 Competitors should be aware that the rock groynes extend underwater and form obstructions.

#### 12 THE START

12.1 The Starting Line will be between the main mast of the Committee Boat displaying an Orange flag at the starboard end and the Yellow pencil cylindrical mark at the port end.

#### 14 THE FINISH

- 14.1 The Finishing Line will be between the main mast of the Committee Boat displaying a Blue flag at the starboard end and Black squat inflatable mark at the port end when the Windward Leeward course is being sailed.
- 14.2 The Finishing Line will be between the main mast of the Committee Boat displaying a Blue flag at the starboard end and the Yellow pencil cylindrical mark at the port end when the Trapezoidal course is being sailed.

#### 17 HEARING REQUESTS

17.4 Hearings will be held in a location as directed on the Notice, and beginning at the time stated on the Notice.

#### 19 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 19.3 Declaration Form(s) will be available in the clubhouse entrance foyer, **for each race** and must be completed within 45 minutes of the last boat finishing any Race, or where races are held back-to-back, the last race of the sequence, for every race.
  - Competitors shall sign-off on the Declaration Form(s) as either having completed the race in accordance with the racing Rules of Sailing and the sailing Instructions for this event, Retired, Protesting, or have completed a one turn penalty.
- 19.4 A boat that retires from a race and promptly after returning to the shore shall complete the Declaration Form(s) appropriate to the relevant race, as having retired.
- 19.5 Adequate personal proprietary buoyancy aids shall be worn properly secured by all competitors at all times whilst afloat. Wetsuits and Drysuits do not constitute adequate personal buoyancy. This is in addition to RRS 1.2 and changes RRS 27.1, 40 and Race Signals 'Y'. No flag signals concerning personal buoyancy will be made.

#### 23 OFFICIAL VESSELS

Official vessels shall comprise the Committee Boat (White Hull, Yellow Topsides), grey and orange RIBS.
